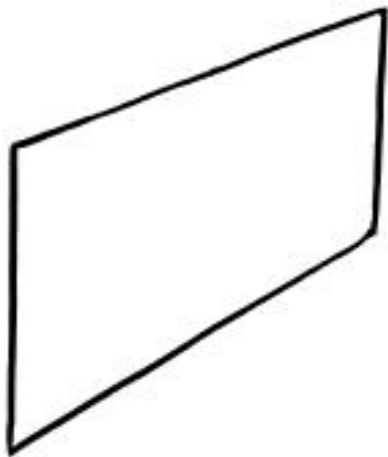


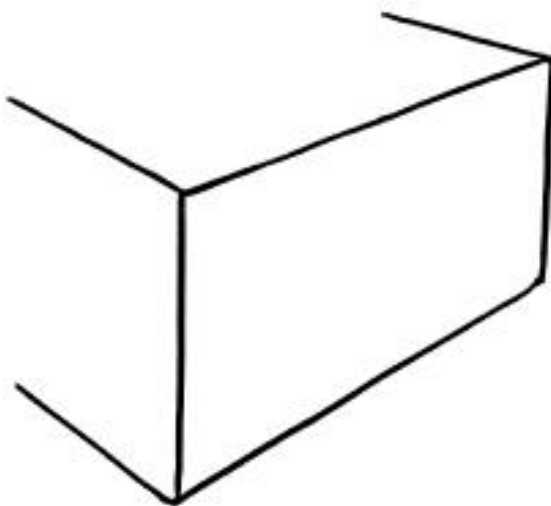
Step 1

Start by drawing a parallelogram on the lower right side of your paper. Think of this shape as a table top, resting on its side.



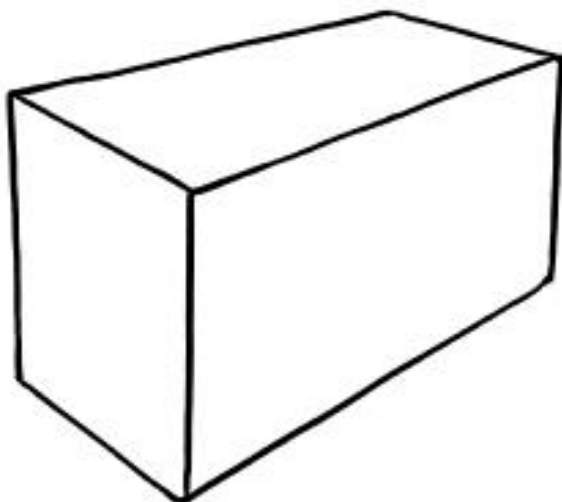
Step 2

Now add legs to the table top. The legs start at the corners, and are equal in length. The angle on each leg is the same.



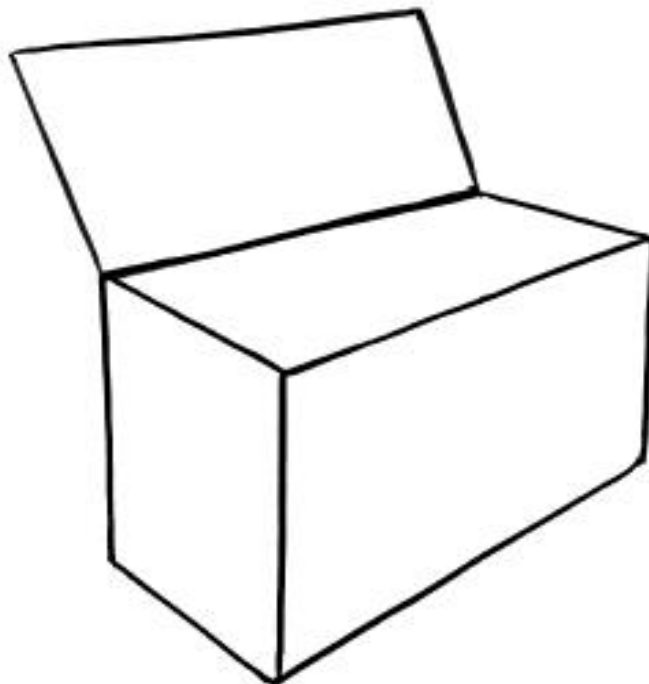
Step 3

Now connect the ends of the legs to complete the box shape. This box will contain the treasure.



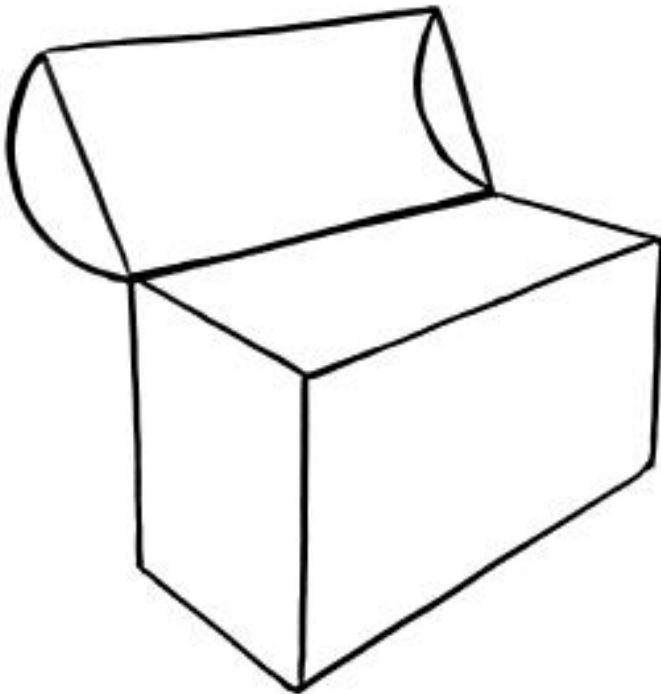
Step 4

Make another parallelogram for the lid.



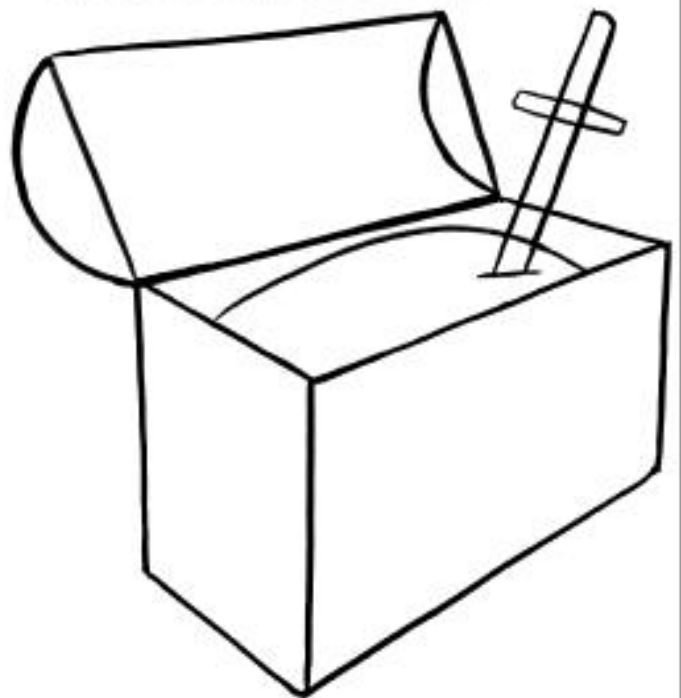
Step 5

Now add half-circles on the lid to transform the rectangle into a 3-dimensional cylinder that has been sliced down the middle.



Step 6

Draw a round shape inside the box. This will become the mound of coins. Thrust a tube shape into the coins, and make sure the tube is rounded on top.



Step 7

Now you can finesse your shapes, adding details, accents and shadows. Think of the coin shapes as very short, wide cylinders.



Final step

Now add color to complete your treasure! Great job!
