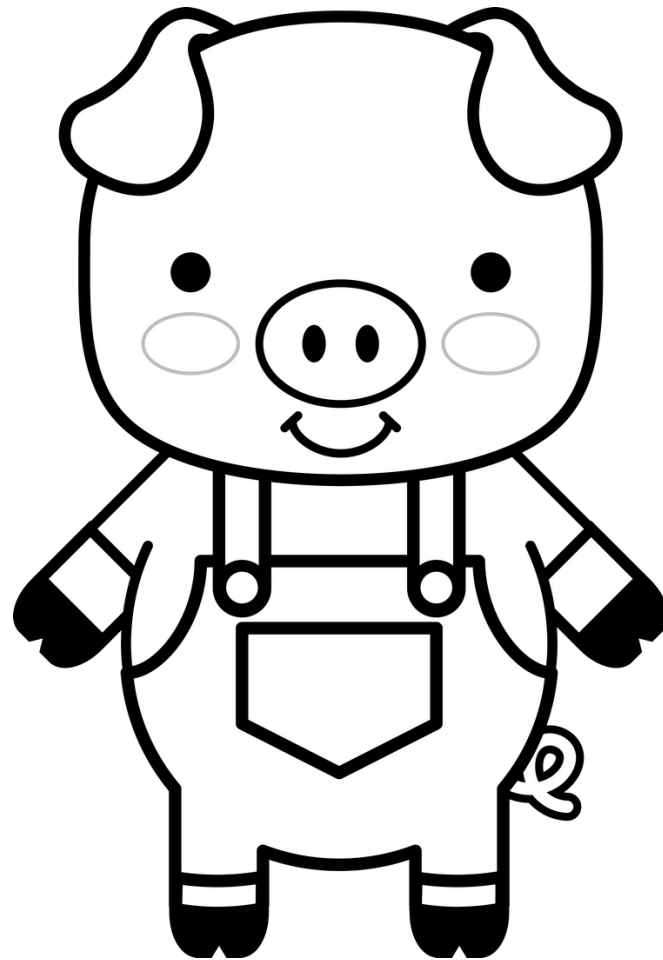

Look at these words.

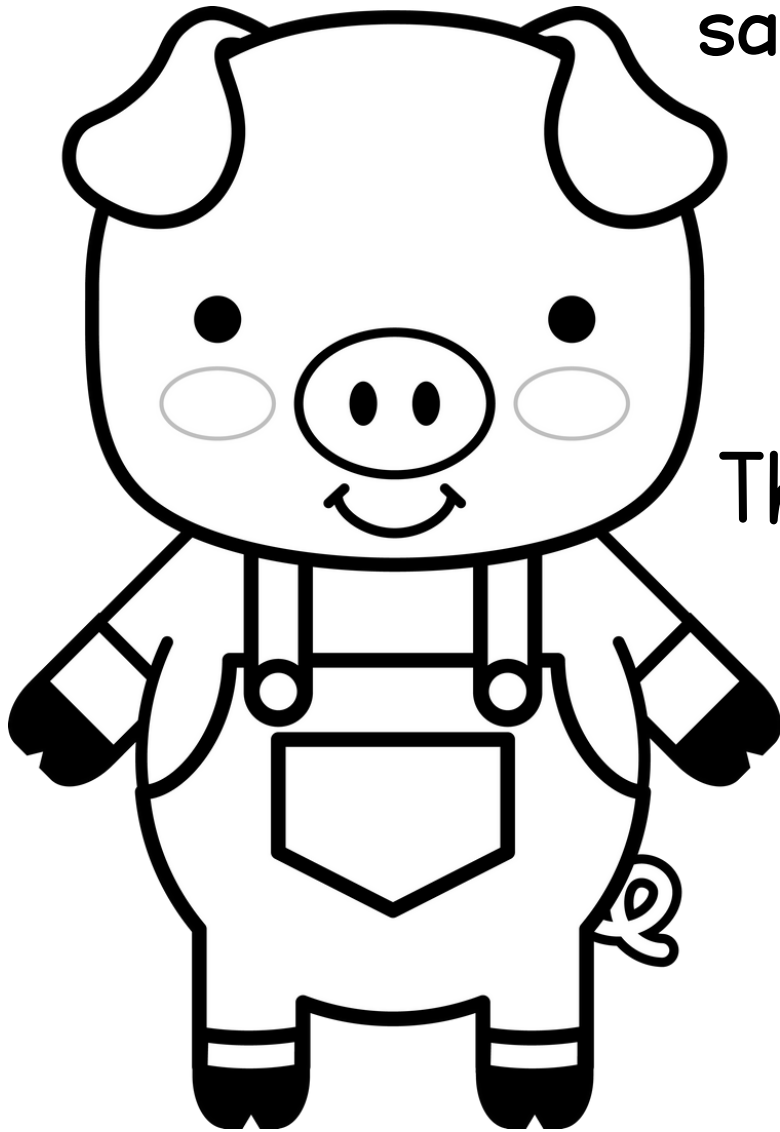
